Objectives and Activities of Cell

- The cell strives to make young girls aware of their legal rights. It empowers them to fight gender discrimination and injustice in professional, domestic and social life.
- To spread Legal Literacy and awareness in neighborhood.
- To identify persons in their neighborhood who deserve legal aid or assistance and who are in need of protecting their rights conferred by law, and to refer those persons for facilitating provision of due and necessary legal assistance to them in accordance with Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 and Rules and Resolutions (under Legal Clinic Aid Services).
- To spread legal literacy and awareness by setting up Rallies, forming small groups of villagers for inter face, making Road shows, distributing pamphlets, study materials etc. containing information regarding Legal Services, Lok Adalat etc., various Government schemes on Poverty Alleviation, Health, Employment, and other social security measures.
- To observe important Days like World Environment Day, World Day against Child Labour, Women's Day, Disability Day, Mental Health Day, Children's Day, National Legal Services Day etc., and spread message in the students and public about the aim and objectives of these Days.
- The cell will conduct various activities such as debates, declamation, poetry, skits, essay writing, slogan writing on issues of socio-legal relevance etc., and motivate the students to participate in these activities.
