Methodolgy Adopted for Feedback:

As per the instruction of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) and Feedback Committee of the college designed feedback forms to collect feedback from students, parents, teachers, alumni and supporting staff. For the session 2020-21, the SSS committee collected feedback through online questionnaires uploaded on institutional website through ERP link. Due to COVID-19 pandemic, students were not present in the institute; all the stakeholders have filled online forms.

Feedback collected from different stakeholders have been analysed to find out the weaknesses and strengths of the institute. All the questionnaire carry few questions related to various aspects e.g. infrastructure, teaching-learning, resources available learning etc. Different criteria have been mentioned in each and every feedback form. Each criterion may consist of different number of questions according to requirement of analysis. Percentages of responses from each questionnaire have been evaluated according to respective criteria.




Figure 1.1: Methodology adopted for feedback system

### **Feedback Outcomes:**

- 1. Majority of the students (87%) have agreed that sufficient number courses are available in the institute. Only 8% have demanded to introduce new courses.
- 2. Students are happy with Student Support System such as financial assistance, Annual awards, freeships and scholarships provided in the college. 74% have agreed on this point while only 2% have suggested some improvements in financial system.
- 3. Nearly 79% of the students are happy with safety measures of the institute. They feel that the environment is soothing and safe for their overall development.
- 4. It is found that majority of the students (82%) have expressed their satisfaction with the library facilities provided in the college.
- 5. Majority of the students (81%) have expressed their satisfaction with the transportation & parking facility.
- 6. Most of the students expressed their satisfaction in the infrastructure provided by institute. Nearly 79% of the respondents have agreed that there are sufficient numbers of facilities available to support their studies.
- 7. Majority of the respondents are happy with the sports facilities like gym, playground etc. Only 7% have asked to start new games and to add new equipments.

8. Large numbers of students (76%) are happy with evaluation system such as class test, term test, and internal assessment. They agreed that teachers follow fair and unbiased way of student evaluation.

# **Suggestions:**

- 1. Although students have expressed their satisfaction with the available range of courses. However, some of them have suggested new including courses related to entrepreneurship and cosmetology.
- 2. As 16% of the respondents disagree with the computer and internet facilities so there is scope for further improvement here. Also, students have demanded free and open Wi-Fi facility in the campus.
- 3. It was found that 15% of the students expressed their dissatisfaction with the medical facilities provided in the campus. As only 57% of the respondents are satisfied so it is recommended to improve medical facilities for the students. Students also demand for a regular doctor in the campus.
- 4. Students also demand for proper sitting area in the campus.
- 5. As per survey only 65% of the respondents expressed their satisfaction with the career counseling & placement and nearly 12% demanded to invite more companies for the placement process. Therefore, there is scope of further improvement in this sector.
- 6. A few suggestions have come regarding improving the grievance redressal mechanism in the campus.
- 7. Many of the students have demanded for free coaching classes for competitive exams.







Fig. 9 Adequate arrangemnt of fests, events and extracurricular activities by the college





### **Feedback outcomes**

- 1. Majority of the parents (92%) are happy with the infrastructural facilities available in the institute. Parents have agreed that adequate learning and online resources have been provided in the college in terms of labs, smart class rooms, library etc. Parents have also appreciated the hostel, library, sports and gym facilities in the college.
- 2. 91% of the parents are satisfied with the report received on their child's performance in the college. 8% of the parents were neutral whereas only 1% has demanded to improve the reporting system of students' performance.
- 3. 83% of the parents are happy with transparency in evaluation system. They are also satisfied with the criteria of evaluation followed by the institute. New additions in evaluation criteria have been asked by 4% of the parents.
- 4. Parents are very happy with co-curricular activities being carried out in the institute. 91% of the parents expressed that institute is carrying appropriate extra-curricular activities that help in overall growth of their ward.
- 5. On analysing the feedback received by the parents, it is observed that parents are largely satisfied by the efforts made by the college administration in security and safety measures (91%). Only 1% of the parents have suggested few points for more safety measures in the institute.

## **Suggestions:**

- 1. Most of the parents are happy with the transparency of evaluation system. Only 4% have demanded improvements in evaluation and performance measure system.
- 2. Some parents have requested to recruit faculty and make arrangements for students who want to prepare for competitive exams.
- 3. As only 76% of the parents are satisfied with the training and placement opportunities, efforts can be made to improve in this sector.





Fig. 5 Infrastructure facilities are adequate to support work culture







#### **Feedback Outcomes**

- 1. The alumni feedback analysis report reveals that majority (92%) of the alumni are happy and proud to be a part of this institution.
- 2. Majority of alumni (90%) agreed with the teaching learning process adopted in the college. 8% stood up neutral while 0% dissatisfaction is reported. A few suggestions came up to include more ICT in teaching learning.
- 3. Almost 84% of the alumni were satisfied that the curriculum being followed in the college helped them to found their suitable jobs. Many alumni are entrepreneurs now based on the skills they gained from their course curriculum. Only 1% of the alumni suggested some changes.
- 4. Majority of the alumni (81%) were satisfied with the infrastructural facilities provided in the college. However, few of the respondents (2%) felt need of some improvements. Nearly 15% of the alumni were neutral on this point.
- 5. The college always stay in touch with alumni through every possible way like social media, phone calls, e-mails etc. Alumni keep giving the suggestions for improvement of college. 1% suggested new ways to interact with college.

## Suggestions by the committee

- 1. Most of the alumni have appreciated the overall teaching-learning process. Few suggestions have come up to add online courses keeping in view the online study due to COVID.
- 2. Although alumni are happy with the course content, some have demanded to add more practical subjects in the curriculum to meet the need of industry.
- 3. Majority of the alumni are happy with the interaction of college with them. It is suggested by a few of them to increase the opportunities of their participation in the activities of the college.





Fig. 10 Motivation of teachers by Institution to carry out research and extension activities





Fig. 12 Efficiency of Examination and Evaluation systems in the colllege

### Feedback outcomes

- ➤ 64% of the faculty members are agreed that the course content offered by university and implemented in the college is according to the need of the students. The course content also match with the need of time. 30% of the faculty is neutral on this point while 6% seek changes in the content.
- As teachers play a pivotal role in implementing the curriculum, the inputs received through the feedback are sent to the concerned Board of studies for consideration. 83% of the faculty is happy with design and curriculum implementation in the university. 11% of the faculty is neutral where no one has shown (0%) dissatisfaction in the implementation.
- The analysis of the teachers' feedback reflects the adequacy and availability of teaching-learning facilities. A big ratio of faculty (70%) is happy with facilities provided in the institution for teaching, learning, evaluation and research whereas 7% faculty members demanded a little improvement in the infrastructure.
- > 73% of the faculty members are satisfied with number of labs and equipments while 24% are neutral. Only 1% has advised to include more facilities in the labs.
- As 75% teachers are happy with the ICT facilities in the campus while 13% have asked to add new ICT facilities in the campus.
- Majority of faculty (76%) is satisfied with the governance in the college.

## Suggestion based on feedback analysis

- ➤ It has been demanded by some of the faculty members that the university should include few online courses in the curriculum to meet the need of this pandemic time. Also teachers should be provided infrastructure to record the lectures.
- ➤ ICT is playing key role in education of today's era. So the faculty has expressed the need for improvement in ICT infrastructure and also for training in the use of the facilities.
- ➤ Various suggestions related to the introduction of different national training programmes are noted for further necessary action.

#### Feedback outcomes

- 1. Majority of the support staff members are happy with work allotment, only a few (5%) have demanded to look into the policy of promoting staff members and their work allotment.
- 2. 92% of the support staff members agreed that placement of employees is according to their abilities. However, 5% have suggested to adopt new policies for placements.
- 3. No one can work efficiently without understanding one's role and responsibility and a large number of employs (82%) have expressed that they understand their job roles and responsibilities clearly. Only the new entrants (5%) have expressed their confusion about their nature of work.
- 4. 81% of the staff agreed that administration is very supportive in every way. However, 8% have suggested improving the process of problem discussion and solution.
- 5. Majority of support staff (87%) is satisfied with infrastructural facilities. Only 5% have expressed that there is need in improvement of infrastructural facilities.




- 1. 15% of the support staff has demanded improvement in promotion policy to increase the satisfaction level of supporting staff.

## Action taken based on the previous year's recommendations

In the session 2020-21, following actions were taken based on the feedbacks received from the different stakeholders. This helped to enhance the satisfaction level of students and other stakeholders:

- ✓ Due to Pandemic, many parents lost their jobs and went through financial crisis. That's why institutional management decided to abolish any type of fine related to student. Although faculty was continuously taking online classes. No class absentee fine was taken.
- ✓ On demand of students, training and placement cell increased their activities and placement drives to get more students recruited in different sectors. Online coaching for competitive exams had been introduced in the college and students are taking benefits from this coaching.
- ✓ From the feedback, the parameters were showing that students are demanding for improved ICT. Due to pandemic, because whole session went online, so institute offered more online workshops and training for the students as well teachers to train to use virtual platforms.
- ✓ All the faculty members have got the open Wi-Fi access in all the buildings.
- ✓ In the previous feedback it was observed from the responses that students were demanding to introduce more skill based courses. In the session 2020-21five skill development courses like B.Voc (E-commerce and Digital Marketing), B.Voc (MLT), B.Voc (Journalism and mass communication), B.Voc (Green House technology), P.G. Diploma in Chemical Analysis of Food were introduced. A number of students got enrolled in these courses.
